

The IEPEC 2013 Mobile App, powered by EventLink and created by Core-apps LLC, is a native application for iPad, smartphones (iPhone and Android), a hybrid web-based app for Blackberry, and there's also a web-based version of the application for all other web browser-enabled phones.

Downloading the IEPEC 2013 Mobile App is easy!

For iPhone (plus iPad & iPod Touch) and Android phones, visit your App Store or Google Play on your device and search for IEPEC 2013.

From there you will be directed to download the proper version of the app for your particular device, or on some phones, bookmark this page for future reference.

To see tips for using the app, please read below.

Tip #1 -- App Updates: Depending upon your Internet connection and how many updates your app is receiving; it may take a few seconds to open. The more frequently you refresh your app, the less time it will take to update.

Tip #2 -- Create a Schedule: Using My Schedule, tap the "+" sign at the top right to manually create a schedule entry.

Tip #3 -- Locate an Event: is as easy as browsing by track or searching all events, selecting a date, then the time when the session or event takes place.

Tip #4 -- Add an Event or Session to your App Schedule with one touch by tapping the star in the upper right-hand corner of the desired events/ sessions page. To remove an event or session from your App Schedule, simply tap the star on the session page again.

Tip #5 -- Locate an Exhibitor: Tap on the Exhibitors icon and view the exhibitors alphabetically, or utilize your search button which will bring up everything related to your search string. If you have bookmarked sponsors, tapping the star in the title bar will display them.

Tip #6 -- Finding a Speaker: You can see an alphabetized list by tapping the Speakers icon, and you can search by pulling down on the list, and typing their name in the search field
